Installation Instructions

The CD is self-loading and will load the Back Paddock Menu.
To install the demonstration program click on 'Back Paddock Demo Installation' and follow the prompts.

To manually start the Software Menu

If the CD does not self-load place the CD Rom in your CDdrive. Click on the "Start" button, then click on the "Run" option and type "D:\backpaddock.exe", replacing "D" with the letter of your CD drive and follow the installation prompts.

To manually install Back Paddock :

If the CD does not self-load place the CD Rom in your CDdrive. Click on the "Start" button, then click on the "Run" option and type " D:\fscommand\BPSAdviserInstall.exe ", replacing "D" with the letter of your CD drive and follow the installation prompts.

When installed:

To update to the latest version please click on "Check for Updates" on the Getting Started Page or go to the Help menu - you will need to be connected to the Internet.

The program will remain in demonstration mode until a licence has been requested and installed.

To Request a Licence:

From either the - Getting Started page select 'Request Licence' from the top right hand corner

Or - go to the Help menu and select 'Licence Manager'.

In the left hand window column select 'User Details' under 'Licence Request' and follow prompts.

To facilitate invoicing include your Trading Name, User Name, Address, Phone no. and the Product (Licence type) in the subject area of the 'Licence Request' email.
